Health and safety at work Act 1974

This is the Health and safety policy statement of St Albans Independent College.

Our Statement of general policy is:

- To create an effective organisational structure and develop a positive health and safety culture to support risk management at all levels within the college;
- To systematically assess and manage risk as an effective approach to the prevention of injury and ill-health
- To ensure the provision of sufficient information, instruction, and supervision to enable all students and members of staff to avoid hazards and contribute positively to their own health and safety and that of others;
- To maintain the school premises in a condition that is safe, secure and without risk to health;
- To formulate effective procedures for use in case of fire and for evacuating the school premises;
- To set procedures to be followed in the case of an accident;
- To provide and maintain adequate facilities for first aid;
- To review the Policy on a regular basis and to ensure that the college keeps abreast of any changes to legislation and compliance issues.
